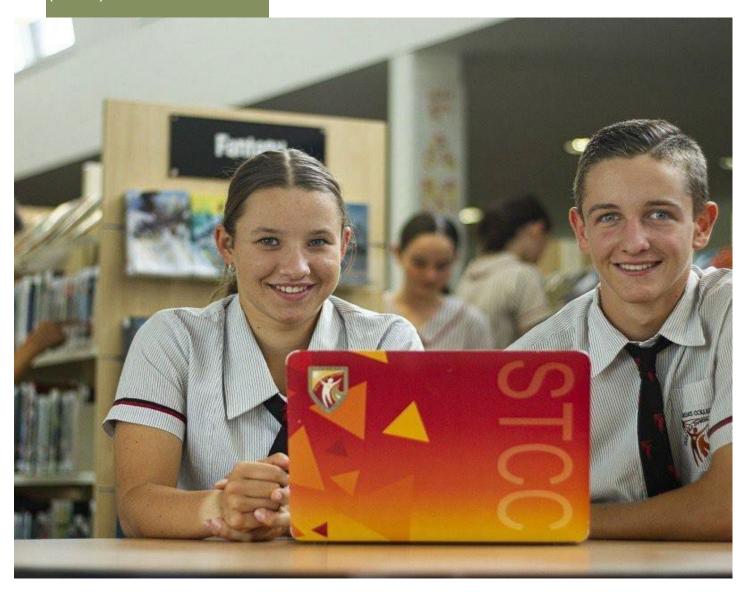

Application Fee

A \$100 non-refundable fee is payable on application for admission to the College.

Enrolment Fee

When a place is offered, an Enrolment Bond of \$500 is payable. \$200 of this amount is retained as a non-refundable enrolment bond. The remaining \$300 will be credited to your account in Term 4 of Year 12. Should enrolment be cancelled any time prior to the student completing Year 12 College Graduation, the bond is non-refundable.

As part of the College enrolment confirmation process for all accepted enrolments, a non-refundable payment of \$700 for the Year 7 Levies, to be paid the year preceding commencement of studies.

Compulsory Capital Levy

This levy is not tax deductible and is used to meet current and future commitments for building projects.

Compulsory Community Levy

This levy is not tax deductible and is used to fund various projects around the College that benefit the whole College population. This may include such projects as shade sails, seating, tables and awnings.

ICT/Subject/Camp Levy

The ICT/Subject/Camp Levy covers a variety of charges including subject and resource expenses, compulsory College camps and retreats, College magazines, ID cards, insurance, whole College sports days, year level and house activities, iPads, laptops, software, licensing, IT technical support.

Additional Senior Specialist Subject and VET Levies

These additional levies for specialist subjects cover additional expenses for particular subjects including extra excursion costs, RTO training and registration fees and specialist materials.

Co-Curricular Activities

The College offers a variety of extracurricular activities such as netball, rugby, water polo, film club, music and drama ensembles, dance troupe and more. Refer to the Sports and Arts Handbooks for further information. These activities need to be paid for prior to commencement of the activity. Approval must be given by the parent/caregiver for any child to participate in any activity.

Instrumental Music (optional)

The College offers a number of ensembles as well as private instrumental lessons. Lessons are invoiced based on 8 to 9 lessons per term and must be paid for by the second week of each term. Refer to the Arts Handbook for further information.

Voluntary Levies

In 2026 a voluntary donation of \$360 per family will be included on your invoice. These levies are tax deductible as they are a voluntary levy. These funds are used towards Capital Building Works (\$200) and to purchase resources for our College Library (\$160).

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Sibling Discounts

Families who also have students at another Catholic school on the Sunshine Coast will receive a discount on the Tuition Fees under the Sibling Discount Scheme. An application is not required. This discount will automatically appear on your statement. (First sibling 5%, second sibling 10%, third sibling 20%, fourth sibling 40%)

Fee Payment Options

Fees and levies will be invoiced at the beginning of each term.

All fees are due 14 days after invoice date, unless the Direct Debit option is arranged.

Direct Debit / Credit Card

The College offers a Direct Debit / Credit Card payment system that allows you to spread the cost of fees over the year. An amount is deducted from your bank account or credit card each week/fortnight/month/term.

Direct debit amounts will not be automatically calculated at the start of each year. Parents/guardians are required to contact the Finance Department to reassess and/or adjust payments. A "College Fee Calculator" is available on the College website to assist with calculations.
